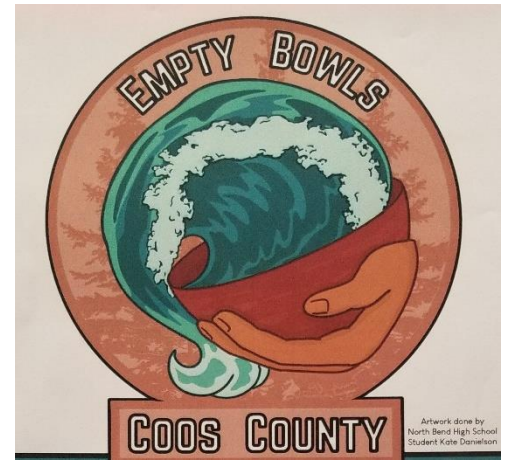
CAMP LUTHERWOOD AUCTION:
