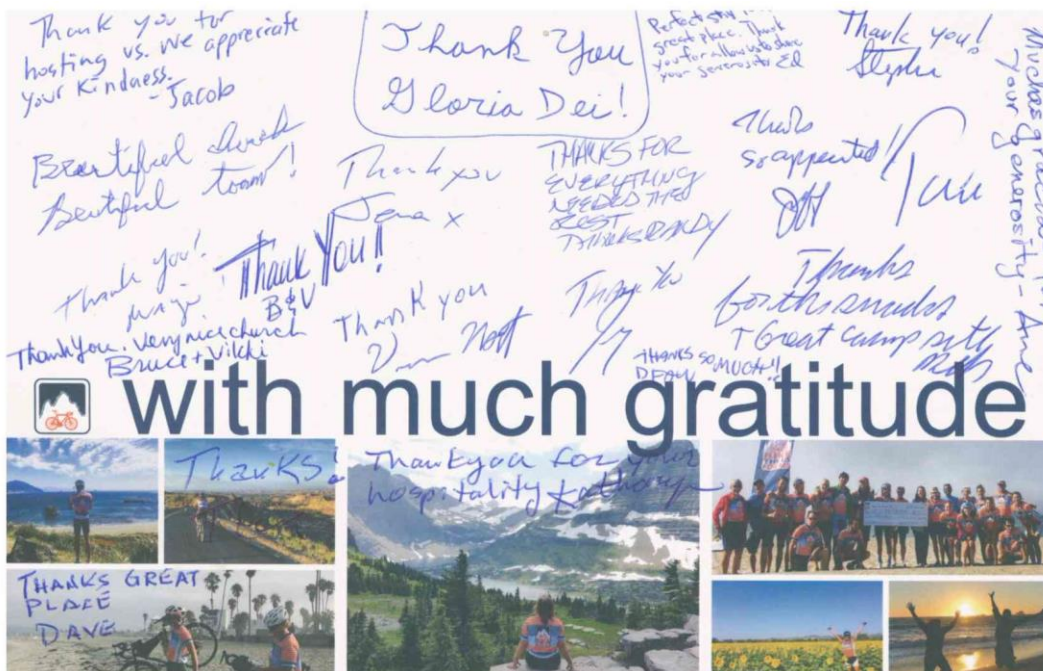
ESTATE SALE!
